

## 2017 OFF THE RAILS | A Route 66 Wine Festival PARTICIPATION AGREEMENT

The applicant for the PARTICIPATION AGREEMENT must be the authorized representative of the organization/business participating in the 2017 Off the Rails Wine Festival. This person must be available to work with IGNITE BRAND MARKETING staff throughout the registration process. A professional event organizer, or other representative, may complete the PARTICIPATION AGREEMENT on behalf of the organization/business provided that a letter of authorization is obtained from the authorized representative. The letter of authorization must be attached to the application.

THIS AGREEMENT is made and entered into, upon approval of the City of Kingman, by and between the Historic Route 66 Association of Arizona ("Association"), a community-based non-profit as described in the 501(c)(3) section of the IRS Code; Ignite Brand Marketing ("Organizer"), a licensed and registered Arizona LLC, the City of Kingman, a municipal corporation organized and existing under and by virtue of the laws of the State of Arizona ("Kingman" or "City"); and the Participation Agreement Applicant.

By signing this written Participation Agreement, the Applicant listed on the application agrees to the following terms and conditions as they relate to their respective role(s):

1. By signing, I agree and understand that I have the sole responsibility at all times to be knowledgeable about, fully understand, and to meet or exceed all local, state and federal codes, laws, policies, and regulations associated with the Event including but not limited to the provisions of the City of Kingman Municipal Code, Special Event Permit Application, other city documents, permits, requirements and/or correspondence.
2. Furthermore, I understand that this property is intended as a venue for the authorized special event periods specified on the permit issued by the City of Kingman to the Association. I and my representatives accept the venue in an as-is condition and are responsible for inspecting all areas within my assigned vendor space and immediate surrounding areas for hazards and will take any necessary steps to protect event participants and attendees until corrective/remedial measures are implemented.
3. I further understand that knowingly providing any false information is cause for the immediate expulsion of the applicant from the Festival. I understand in the event of a major incident, Off the Rails | A Route 66 Wine Festival may be postponed or terminated for the sake of public safety and welfare (e.g., major crime incident, fire, flood, or any act of nature). I further understand that in the event the Special Event Permit applied for by the Foundation is denied by the City, then the Festival will not take place.
4. I acknowledge I am legally and financially responsible for the overall organization, management, and implementation of my Vendor Booth and its related activities. If the Primary Contact on the Agreement is not the same as the Applicant or of the organization/business conducting the event, I authorize the Primary Contact to represent me throughout the registration process and event duration, including set-up and dismantle timeframes.
5. I hereby agree to defend, indemnify, and hold harmless the Association, the Organizer and the City of Kingman, and their agents, officials, and employees from and against any and all loss, damages, liability, claims, suits, costs and expenses, whatsoever, including attorney's fees, regardless of the merit or outcome of any such claim or suit arising from or in any manner connected to or from this Agreement.
